Dementia Safety Checklist

Use this checklist when memory loss begins creating safety concerns at home.

Daily Safety

- ☐ Medication errors or missed doses
- ☐ Unsafe cooking or stove use
- ☐ Poor nutrition or dehydration
- ☐ Difficulty using phone in an emergency

Wandering & Driving

- ☐ Gets lost in familiar places
- ☐ Attempts to leave home unexpectedly
- ☐ Driving concerns or accidents
- ☐ Needs ID and emergency contact plan

Home Risks

- ☐ Fall hazards and poor lighting
- ☐ Weapons, tools, or chemicals accessible
- ☐ Financial scams or unusual spending
- ☐ Pets or household duties no longer managed

When to Act

- ☐ Multiple safety incidents in 30 days
- ☐ Caregiver cannot rest or leave safely
- ☐ Police, EMS, or neighbors become involved
- ☐ Family feels the current plan is not sustainable
