UTI Symptoms in Seniors

Why sudden confusion, weakness, or behavior changes should be taken seriously.

Possible Signs

- ☐ Sudden confusion or delirium
- ☐ New weakness or fatigue
- ☐ Falls or unsteady walking
- ☐ Agitation or behavior changes

Urinary Signs

- ☐ Pain or burning with urination
- ☐ Urgency or frequency
- ☐ Foul-smelling or cloudy urine
- ☐ New incontinence

What To Do

- ☐ Call the doctor promptly
- ☐ Ask whether testing is needed
- ☐ Encourage fluids if allowed medically
- ☐ Do not ignore sudden mental status changes

After Treatment

- ☐ Confirm antibiotics are taken correctly
- ☐ Watch for dehydration
- ☐ Review fall risk after weakness
- ☐ Track recurring infections
